Diocesan Education Leaders' Programme 2021-2022

The Diocesan Education Leaders' Programme (DELP)

If you are a new DDE, Deputy DDE or aspiring DDE, joining with leaders from across the country will enable you to deepen your Calling, widen your professional network and nuance your skills in navigating the complex landscape of leading within a diocese.

Over 15 months, you will learn from subject experts, peers and experienced DDEs and become part of a community which is engaged in reflective practice. Your learning will include a 2-day residential at Launde Abbey, your selection of two virtually delivered modules, membership of an action learning set facilitated by an experienced DDE, and a final face to face learning event.

In the overview of events below, you will complete module 1a or 1b, module 2, and either module 3a or 3b.
