

Please Note:



- 1. A participant is likely to be considered 'borderline' if the information provided in their application form does not clearly demonstrate evidence of working at senior leadership level.
- 2. A telephone interview will be conducted by the partner school within the region that the applicant has applied to be part of. In the interview further clarity will be sought about the applicant's readiness for headship.
- 3. Applicants are required to discuss their choice of mentor with their diocese before including their name within the application. This process is designed to prevent issues with mentors being highlighted later.
- 4. Applicants will be asked for permission for the Foundation of Educational Leadership to share their personal information with both partner schools and their diocese. This is because the CofEPQH is delivered in partnership between these three key groups.
- 5. In the case of an application being rejected, this may be on the grounds of the applicant not demonstrating that they are yet working at the right level, lack of evidence of readiness for headship, or because a regional group has reached its full capacity.
- 6. In the case of a regional group becoming full, where possible we will offer successful applicants the opportunity to take part in a different regional group as a second choice.
