Mentors challenge, inspire, encourage, and support participants throughout the CofEPQH.

Who can be a mentor?

CofEPQH participants are expected to identify a mentor who is a serving or recent head from a different school.

How much time will mentors offer?

Participants will meet with their mentor for at least five 1 hour sessions during the course of their CofEPQH programme (Feb 2020-June 2021).

What do mentors do?

- Help the individual define and set their learning goals
- Encourage the individual to reflect on their learning, challenge their assumptions and stretch their thinking
- Support the individual to extract learning from their school placements and write this up into their two NPQ assignments
- Provide advice and support for the NPQH assignments

What professional development do mentors receive?
