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NPQ Leading Behaviour and Culture (NPQLBC) is a nationally recognised, professional qualification for Teachers, Support Staff and anyone working in a relevant role in a school. It's great for those who are leading behaviour, working in a pastoral role or are working to lead inclusion whether you work in a primary or secondary school or an FE college.

Validated by the DFE and EEF, our evidence-based, rigorous NPQLBC gives teachers a superb understanding of how to develop and implement behaviour and wellbeing strategies in their school.

What will I learn?

Develop evidence-led expertise equipping you to respond effectively to the challenges and opportunities of ensuring great behaviour and pupil wellbeing, enabling the flourishing of children and adults through an ambitious vision for your area of the school. This course will help you develop skills and gain the confidence to enact changes in:

- Setting a culture of high expectations and learning in your school
- Enabling conditions for good behaviour for pupils and ensuring colleagues are supported in their classroom-level approaches
- Supporting pupil well-being and understanding the impact this has on behaviour

How will I learn?

You will learn through a series of four 'teaching cycles', covering 1-2 units in each. In each teaching cycle you will attend an online webinar per unit, complete self-study activities, attend a coaching session and attend a half-day face-to-face knowledge application sessions.

NPQLBC is a 12-month, evidence informed course. During the programme you'll be introduced to the latest research and evidence-based practice. You'll also focus on how you can, practically, apply this research in your own school.
