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NPQ Leading Teacher Development (NPQLTD) is a nationally recognised, professional qualification for Teachers. It's perfect for those who are or would like to mentor Early Careers Teachers or those who are interested in Leading Professional Development in their schools.

Validated by the DFE and EEF, our evidence-based, rigorous NPQLTD gives teachers a superb understanding of how to support and develop those around you, ensuring everyone leads pupils to do their very best.

Why study the NPQLTD?

This course will help you gain confidence and develop skills in:

- implementing evidence-based professional development programmes focused on improving classroom teaching
- promoting a strong professional development culture across their school

This course covers themes including:

- designing and delivering effective professional development
- how to make informed evidence-based professional development decisions
- techniques for tailoring and adapting support based on individual development needs

How will I learn?

You will learn through a series of four 'teaching cycles', covering 1 unit in each. In each teaching cycle you will attend an online webinar per unit, complete self-study activities and attend face-to-face knowledge application sessions. The NPQFlex route provides more flexibility to the course organiser in your organisation to incorporate some of the learning into directed time.

What will my NPQLTD cover?

NPQLTD is a 12 month, evidence informed course. You can start in November or February. During the programme you'll be introduced to the latest research and evidence based practice, in 4 key areas.

You'll also focus on how you can, practically, apply this research in your own school.
